**>>> OSHA TRAINING**  
40 Students

NICE has sponsored OSHA-10 training for two schools in 2023-2024 resulting in 40 additional students receiving OSHA-10 training. In person training is valuable when it comes to safety, and being able to facilitate these sessions is meaningful for industry preparation. We are looking at ways to expand our ability to provide OSHA training.

NICE engaged 235 Seniors from 21 different high schools in Senior Visits with local labor partners. These experiences are designed to increase student awareness of apprenticeship and training programs to get them industry ready out of high school. Interested in hosting a visit please reach out.

The Institute for Shaping the Built Environment is NICE's middle-school design build competition. We engaged with 7 schools and 120 students this year. This experience gives students insight into the design-build process and teaches teamwork as well as integrated math and business concepts.



**>>> iBUILD SHOWCASE**  
~2,500 Students

iBuild Showcase remains one of the largest hands-on experiences for students in the region. Final metrics are being tabulated, however, we show approximately 2500 students in attendance from 37 high schools and 18 middle schools. Students were able to explore activities from over 50 local companies set up in 49 exhibit spaces.
